- IN ORDERING, PLEASE ONLY STATE NUMBER AND PRICE OF ARTICLE WANTED. The Number refers us to the description and the Price designates the quantity. Write Plainly your own name, and that of your Town, County and State, also Express Office directions with the larger orders and give the number and name of street if your place has the carrier system.
- ORDER BLANKS and printed envelopes, for the special convenience of our patrons, will be sent free to any address.
- OUR TERMS are invariably "Cash" With The Order." Our prices, are very low and we cannot afford to open accounts and extend credit on small purchases. To wholesale dealers and jobbers who send us satisfactory references we will make special terms.
- C. O. D. ORDERS.—We can send goods and collect the money on delivery only when enough money is sent to prepay the Expressage, and thus protect us from loss, should the person not take the goods from the Express Co., as is sometimes the case. We would, however, advise remitting in advance, as the expense of return charges on C. O. D. packages are thereby saved to customers. To those who buy the heavier goods, viz: Cards, Papers, Inks. &c., in large quantities we advise transportation by freight as it is much cheaper. Many of our customers take advantage of this fact and more should do so.
